
Clovelly Park South noise barriers

Noise and visibility barriers of the Darlington Expressway must be aesthetically pleasing to Clovelly Park South residents. The Southern expressway noise and visibility barriers are not fine views for Darlington and Sturt residents. We



await the promised landscaping from the State Government to alleviate these eyesore barriers, and expect the Clovelly Park South residents to receive noise and visibility barriers more like those just north of the Anzac Highway and South Road intersection.

Connecting Clovelly Park to Flinders Medical and University



It is expected that Flinders Drive will extend over the Darlington Expressway down to Sturt Road, with stoplights to allow movement into Birch Crescent. Not only are there opportunities for cycling and walking connections to Flinders Medical and Flinders

University, but also there must be allowance made for light rail extension from Tonsley station on into Flinders University.

New lighting and running track at Mitchell Park.

The Mitchell Park Sports and Community Centre now has lights on its oval that now allow sports practices of its football and rugby teams of an evening. The running and walking track around the perimeter has been installed under a State Grant. The new track will be a popular feature for nearby residents.
